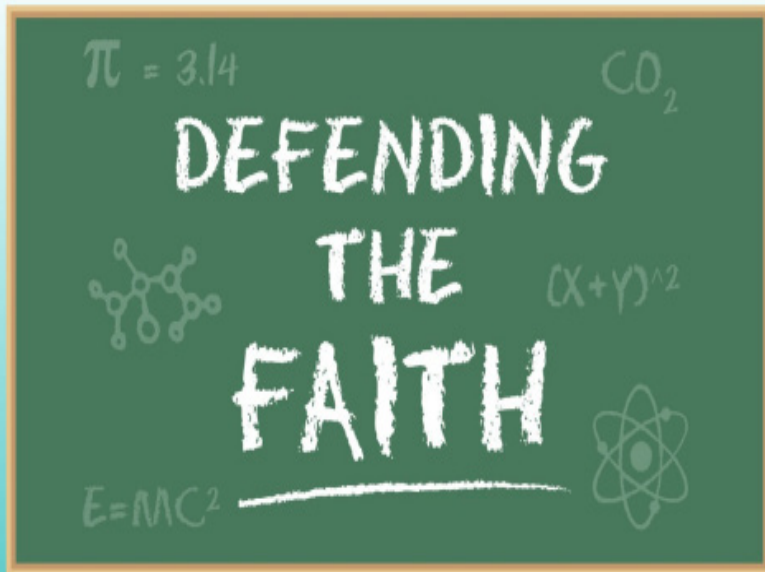

REMINDER!!!**



We would like to remind everyone that before school starts up again in August, all students will need a **current physical exam**. For all incoming 6th grade students, a scoliosis exam will need to be part of the routine physical.

Student immunizations must also be current.

Immunization requirements are listed below:

Kindergarten-12th grade:

- Four or five doses of DtaP
- Four or five doses of IPV
- Three doses of MMR
- Three doses of Hep B
- One Tdap
- Two doses of Varicella

Additional Immunization requirements

for 7th grade entry:

- One Tdap
